AN ORDINANCE To Amend The Code Of The Township Of Lower Merion, Chapter 145, Entitled Vehicles And Traffic, Article XV, Schedules, §145-120, Schedule XX: Traffic and Parking Regulations on Public Property, By Establishing No Parking And Limited Parking Regulations For The Ardmore, Bala Cynwyd And Gladwyne Libraries.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Lower Merion hereby ordains:

Section 1. The Code of the Township of Lower Merion, Chapter 145, entitled Vehicles and Traffic, Article XV, Schedules, §145-120, Schedule XX: Traffic and Parking Regulations on Public Property, is hereby amended by adding thereto in alphabetical order the following regulations:

§145-120. Schedule XX: Traffic and Parking Regulations on Public Property

In accordance with the provisions of § 145-31, the movement and parking of vehicles in the parking lots, parks, playgrounds and other municipally owned or leased properties described below are subject to the regulations indicated.

Area Regulation

Ardmore Library

No parking on both sides of driveway
Parking for library patrons only in library parking lot.

Bala Cynwyd Library

No parking on both sides of driveway
Parking for library patrons only in library parking lot.

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Gladwyne Library

No parking on both sides of driveway
Parking for library patrons only in library parking lot.

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Section 2. Nothing in this Ordinance or in Chapter 145 of the Code of the Township of Lower Merion, as hereby amended, shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding in any Court, any rights acquired or liability incurred, any permit issued, or any cause or causes of

Section 3. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part, or provision thereof shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts, or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board that this Ordinance would have been adopted as if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part, or provision had not been included herein.
