I. Action To Be Considered By The Board:

Approve a reimbursement agreement for the reconstruction of the Pennswood Road Bridge.

II. Why This Issue Requires Board Consideration:

Funding for the bridge reconstruction is through PennDOT's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). PennDOT requires the Township to enter into the reimbursement agreement which will fund the project 80% Federal, 15% State, and 5% Local (Township).

III. Current Policy Or Practice (If Applicable):

The agreement designates the Township match funding and requires Board approval.

IV. Other Relevant Background Information:

This bridge is an orphan bridge and must be reconstructed due to its age and deterioration.

V. Impact On Township Finances:

This project is funded through the Capital Improvement Program. Once rebuilt, the Township will retain ownership and maintenance responsibilities for the bridge. The Township's 5% match portion of the cost is \$245,900.

VI. Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends authorizing execution of the Reimbursement Agreement.
