AN ORDINANCE To Amend The Code Of The Township Of Lower Merion Chapter 13, Environmental Advisory Council, Section 13-2, Composition, To Increase The Maximum Composition Of The Council To Nine; Alternatively, The Board May Appoint Two Alternate Members To Serve If Needed To Create A Quorum.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Lower Merion hereby ordains:

Section 1. The Code of the Township of Lower Merion, Chapter 16, Health Advisory Council, §16-3, Composition, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

§13-2. Composition.

The Environmental Advisory Council shall be composed of not more than <u>seven-nine</u> and not fewer than five residents of the Township of Lower Merion.

Alternatively, upon enactment, the Board will consider the following rather than the above:

The Environmental Advisory Council shall be composed of not more than seven and not fewer than five residents of the Township of Lower Merion. <u>In addition, the Board may appoint two alternate members to serve by appointment of the chair to create a quorum.</u>

Section 2. Nothing in this Ordinance or in the Code of the Township of Lower Merion, as hereby amended, shall be construed to affect any suit or proceedings in any Court, any rights acquired or liability incurred, any permit issued, or any cause or causes of action existing prior to the adoption of this amendment.

Section 3. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part, or provision thereof shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of this court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part, or provision had not been included herein.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take affect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.
